PRAIA

Praia has a cosmopolitan culture. People of African ancestry are the majority in the city, mainly because of the centuries old slave trade and plantation economy of the islands, but there is still a significant European population including many Portuguese. The African influence predominates in the languages, food, and social patterns. The European influence can be seen in the Catholic religion, urban architecture, and clothing. Like other former Portuguese colonies there is a significant Kriol (creole) culture as a result of the intermarriage of many Portuguese and Africans.



QUINTAL DE MISCA

Quintal da Música is a space that combines gastronomy and culture in the very centre of Praia. Typical Cape Verdean cuisine is served to the backdrop of nightly live traditional music. Nationally and internationally renowned artists have delighted customers here with their music, an experience that keeps them coming back time and time again.



SANTIAGO ISLAND TOUR

The largest island in the archipelago and home to Cape Verde's capital, Praia, Santiago is an island rich in history, while also functioning as the main hub for inter-island transport across the country. Green valleys and lush plantations meet rugged mountains and bustling African towns, offering visitors yet another side to Cape Verde's impressive diversity.

CIDADE VELHA

Cidade Velha (literally, "Old City"), which is the very spot where life on Cape Verde began. This was the place where the very first Portuguese settlers landed, soon creating a military base around which within four years a town had grown. Originally naming it Ribeiro Grande, the Portuguese rapidly built a lucrative trading post between Africa and the Americas, once again involving the trading of African slaves as one of its commodities



SAL

Century-old churches, ruins, and monuments make this a unique destination. Renowned for its sublime beaches, Angra dos Reis is home to lots of history, even at the bottom of the ocean. This extraordinary region will simply amaze you! Located about 160 km from the city of Rio de Janeiro, Angra dos Reis and its clear blue-green waters offer tourists the possibility to visit a different island every day of the year. The region includes more than 360 islands and approximately two thousand beaches covered in lush native Atlantic Forest vegetation, which makes it a favorite spot among visitors who enjoy sunshine and beach activities.



TURTLE WALK

Once arrived to the beach one of the guides will stay with you seated on the sand while the other guide will start searching for the turtle. When the guide finds a turtle, you will be informed by VHF radio and start walking on the beach to arrive to the turtle. It is recommended to bring a beach towel to be more comfortable while waiting on the beach. Dark colored clothes and closed shoes are recommended.
