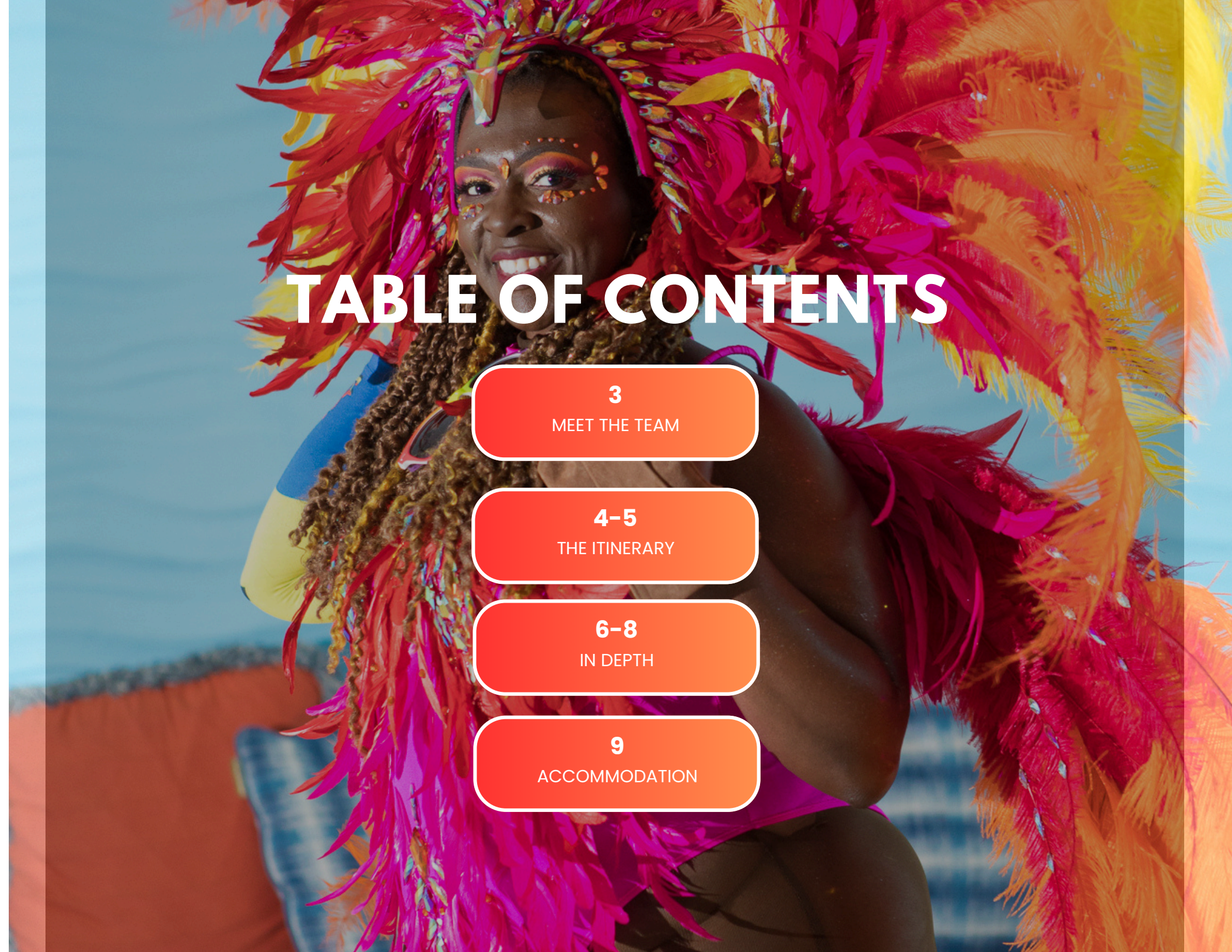

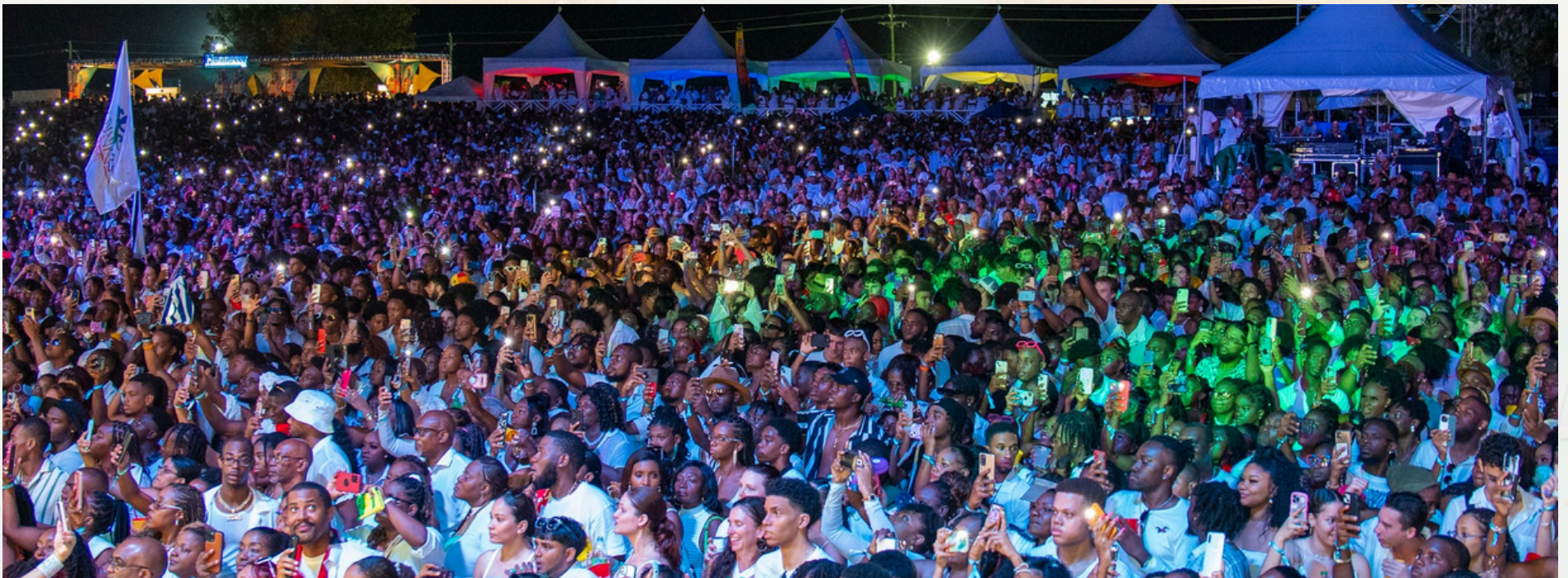
GRAND KADOOMENT

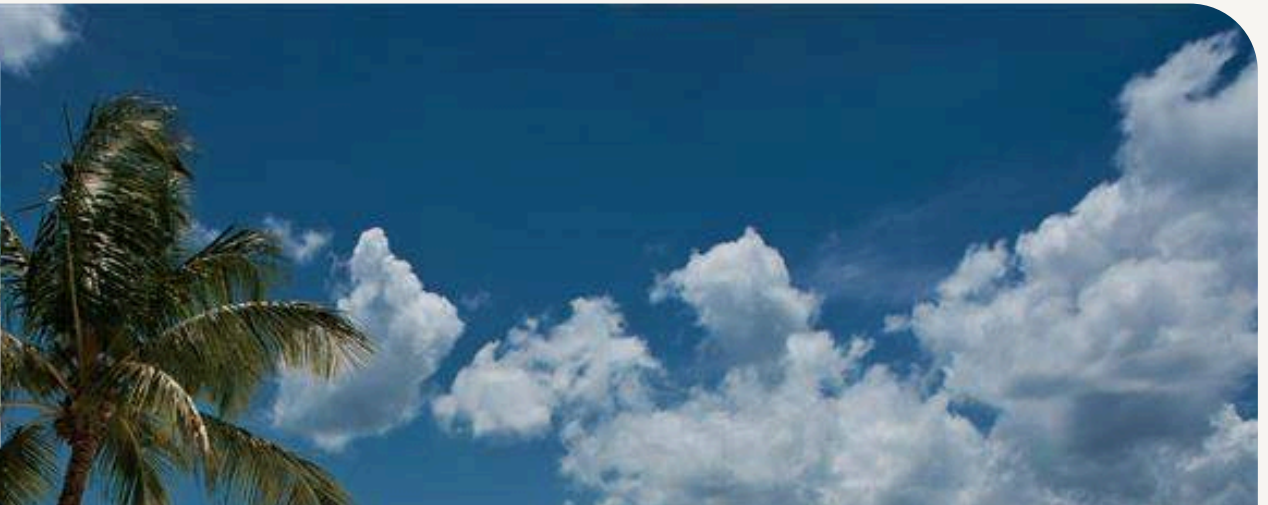
BLISS PREMIUM ALL-INCLUSIVE FÊTE
